An electrical helper assists journeyman and foreman electricians in installing and troubleshooting electrical wiring and equipment. This course is designed for students with little to no previous experience who are looking to pursue a career in the electrical field.

- Introduction to the National Electrical Code®
- Wireways, raceways, and fittings

- Conductors and cables
- Residential electrical services
- Electrical test equipment

Students who complete this course will receive a certification from the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER). An NCCER certification demonstrates that the holder is highly trained, knowledgeable, and qualified to do the job anywhere in the country.
