

NURSING ASSISTANT

The nursing assistant training is designed to teach students the essential skills needed to provide basic care to patients in a hospital, long-term care facility, home health, assisted living, or rehabilitation facility.

What you will learn:

- Introduction to long-term care
- Personal care skills
- Basic nursing skills
- Simulated patient environment
- Nurse assistant clinical practice at a long-term care facility

This six- or nine-week course will prepare students to take the state exam for a certified nurse aide (CNA).

- Authorization to work (Social Security, birth certificate, work visa, or green card)
- High school diploma/GED preferred, but not required
- Must pass a criminal background check
- Proof of a negative tuberculosis test within the last year
- Passing score on entrance assessment(s)
