PHLEBOTOMIST

The phlebotomy training course will prepare an individual for work in a clinical lab in hospitals, laboratories, physician's offices, and other healthcare settings where blood samples are taken and analyzed.

What you will learn:

- Basic anatomy and physiology, blood and cell composition
- Blood sampling procedures
- Laboratory safety
- Blood drawing procedures such as basic venipuncture techniques, butterfly techniques, heel puncture, and capillary puncture

Note: All students must attend mandatory orientation before the first day of class.
